**Notice of Petition for Forfeiture and Summons by Publication**

The Tulalip Tribes Office of Reservation Attorney gives notice that the property listed below was seized for forfeiture for violation of Tribal Law. Laws and procedures applicable to the forfeiture process can be found in Tulalip Tribal Code (TTC) Chapters 2.10 and 2.60. **TO FILE A CLAIM:** If you are an owner or claimant, you may contest the forfeiture of the property listed below by filing an answer with the Tribal Court no later than 30 days after the date of final publication of this notice. You must serve a copy of your answer on the Tribal Prosecutor. You may request a copy of the summons, petition, and evidence in your case from the Tribal Prosecutor.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, has filed a petition with the Court that seeks to have forfeited, to the benefit of the Tribes, certain property that you allegedly own, claim, or have an interest.

Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(a), of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law, you have thirty (30) days after you have been served the petition and this summons to file with the Court a response to the allegations described in the petition. No extension of the time for filing the response may be granted. Failure to respond within 30 days may bar you from presenting evidence at any later evidentiary hearing regarding the seized property. Further, if no response is filed within 30 days after service of the petition and summons, the Court, upon motion of the Tribes, shall order the property forfeited to the Tribes.



COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

**I. SUBJECT PROPERTY**

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #19-0362, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2019, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2018 Chrysler 300S, VIN #2C3CCABG1JH223024 from Shane Grant (driver) in the vicinity of 10200 Quil Ceda Blvd., Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking and felony firearms possession charges on the Tulalip Reservation.

**II. AUTHORITY**

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1 The Subject Vehicle was used to store a firearm and transport said firearm and Shane  
2 Grant, a convicted felon, to the Reservation. A felon in possession of a firearm is a felony under  
3 tribal, federal, and state law. Any instrumentality used, or intended to be used, in any manner or  
4 part, to commit, or to facilitate, the commission of any Class F crime as defined by Tulalip Tribal  
5 law. Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(10).

6 **III. CLAIMANTS**


7 Shane Grant, driver/registered owner, from whom the subject property was seized, the  
8 other registered owner of the vehicle, Lauren Grant, and the legal owner of the vehicle, Boeing  
9 Employees Credit Union, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has  
10 or may asset a claim to the subject property. Shane Grant is believed to reside at 12433  
11 Admiralty Way, Apt. M103, Everett, Washington 98204 (Police Report). Lauren Grant is  
12 believed to reside at 12433 Admiralty Way, Apt. H101, Everett, Washington 98204 (Police  
13 Report). Boeing Employees Credit Union mailing address is P.O. Box 997500, Sacramento,  
14 California 95899 (Police Report).

15 **IV. CONCLUSION**

16 Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons  
17 to have Shane Grant, Lauren Grant, and Boeing Employees Credit Union answer the allegations  
18 of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for  
19 the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
