## How can I join?

## How often will my provider visit?

Weekly or as desired until client is ready to exit from the Team Outreach Program.

## Teen Advocate Outreach mission statement

A program that provides intensive outreach support for Native American females ages 12 to 25, that need assistance with tribal health services, education, being more involved with their community and most importantly their families.

Our staff consistently works with youth and young adults through negative suicidal thoughts, depression and anxiety. We encourage youth and young adults to remain in school and we push our clients to further their education.

Our Outreach program provides support for youth and young adults that are struggling with addiction and helps clients develop positive and healthy relationships with others around them and within their community.

## Our outreach program offers these services to clients

- Offering clients the opportunity to learn more about their culture and their history
- Assisting clients in working towards their high school diploma or GED
- Helping clients develop healthy coping skills and implementing safety plans
- Providing support for clients working towards their own individualized goals
- Helping our clients re-engage in their community and tribal support services
- Teaching client life skills and building independence such as setting up doctor/dental appointments, finding housing, building resumes, etc.
- Offering consistent support for clients struggling with drug or alcohol abuse
- Assisting clients with any court-related issues or probation and fines
