The Tulalip Tribes Events Department is requesting letters of interest for the preparation of the meal served during the Paddle to Elwha Canoe Journey.

MUST BE AVAILABLE TO TRAVEL WITH CANOE JOURNEY GROUP: July 27 – August 6 (Dates are subject to change)

LETTER OF INTEREST WILL NEED TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- a. Purchase, preparation and serving of all food for up to 200+ people
- b. Preparation of breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks for all days listed while on Canoe Journey
- c. Set up and tear down of meal tents at each stop
- d. Clean-up of the kitchen and tables at each stop
- e. Take into consideration, dietary restrictions such as diabetic members, etc.
 - a. Supply a full daily menu
 - b. Supply healthy options for those with dietary restrictions
- f. Copy of Food Handlers permits/certificates for each person working in the kitchen
- g. Please list previous experience cooking for traditional gatherings
- h. At the conclusion of journey, the cook will be required to clean and organize the food trailer prior to its return
- i. Provide a detailed letter of interest, in which you describe in detail, the following:
 - a. Past cooking experience (with dates and timeframes listed)
 - b. Why you are the best choice
- j. Payment will be given at the end of Canoe Journey final date
- k. Head Cook must provide the full name of Assistant Cook in the letter
- 1. Urinalysis test must be performed in accordance to the Events Cook's Policy
- m. This is a drug and alcohol free event
- n. Tulalip Events follows the TERO Preference Policy.

Pay for the event:

Head Cook: \$500.00 per day Assistant Cook: \$250 per day

Cook must be available for non-stipend communication with Events Manager or designee, leading up to preparation and departure of event. Cook must have a cell phone with ability to receive voicemails. (voicemail inbox must not be full)
