My parents are Audrey Charles and Steve Jones Sr., Both are from Tulalip. My Grandparents are Helen Prouty (Hatch), Wesly & Tiny Charles, Florence McKay (Williams), and George C. Jones Jr. (deceased before I was born). My Great Grandparents were Katherine "Molly" Hatch (Fryberg), Donald Hatch Sr., Nora Dillon, Joseph Charles Sr., Martin and Margaret Williams, and George Jones Sr. and Juanita Giddings.

Fortunately, I was able to grow up very close with most of my grandparents. Growing up, I always enjoyed being around them and helping them when I could. Before my great-grandpa Martin passed, I still remember him calling me his little dishwasher when I was a little girl. It's a fond memory that makes me smile. I would always ride with my grandmother Florence (Martin's daughter) and my parents, and a lot of the time, Esther Reeves would be with us. We would go to yard sales or for rides to the woods hunting or berry picking. I was always also down at Esther and Tom Reeves' house visiting.
