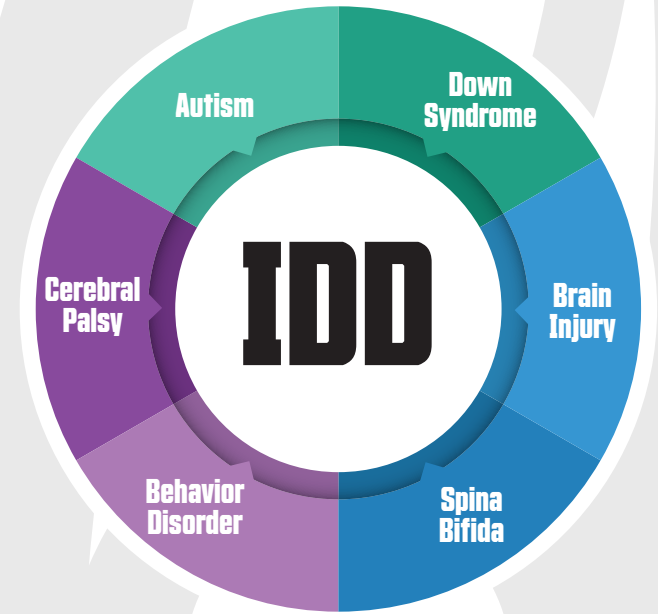

Tulalip Tribal families with children birth to five years old with suspected delays due to intellectual or developmental disability (IDD).

How Can I Join?

Families may be referred by Betty J. Taylor Early Learning Academy, Tulalip Health Clinic, or self-referred.

Our Case Managers will staff the referral and reach out to the family within 72 hours from when the referral is submitted.
