Dear Higher Education Student,

First of all, we hope you are adapting to COVID-19 as a student and we wish you the best of luck in your educational journey. We heard from students worried by the reduction in funding for room/board and stipend for those over the age of 25. We understand that you have created budgets based on Tulalip education funding. We have decided to allow students who are already committed to their degree program to continue utilizing the room/board and stipend until the current degree is complete. To qualify, students need to have been enrolled in their current degree program before Spring term 2020.

Therefore, in the Fall 2020 term, you may request payment for stipend and room/board following the same procedure as before. When you complete your current degree, you will then follow the adopted Life Long Learning policy.
