Who can participate?

Tulalip youth who were in foster care at the age of 15 or older, and/or in extended foster care up to the age of 23.



How can we help?

Assistance with:

- Transitional and permanent housing
- Birth certificates, school transcripts, passport, etc.
- Social services (such as TANF, food stamps, etc.)
- Setting, prioritizing and accomplishing goals
- Limited transportation services
