The Tulalip Tribes Planning Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, July 22, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.** at Quil Ceda Village Business Park Conference Room at 8802 27th Avenue N.E., Tulalip, WA 98271

The purpose of the public hearing is to allow all interested persons an opportunity to comment on proposed revisions to the 1994 Tulalip Tribes Comprehensive Land Use Plan, which is the Tribes' official statement concerning future growth and development.

The proposed amendments considered for a recommendation for adoption include Narrative Text, Goals and Policies Amendments, and Amendments to Future Land Use Map. Nine (9) proposed elements of the Comprehensive Plan for revision include Land Use, Environment, Cultural Resources, Environment, Housing, Reservation Economy, Transportation, Utilities, Governmental Facilities and Services, and Open Space, Parks, and Recreation.
